

JOB DESCRIPTION/JOB ANALYSIS FOR THE POST OF
VETERINARY OFFICER (BS-17)

Main Responsibilities and Tasks

Each Veterinary Officer can be appointed to perform any one of the job specified as under:-

1. He is responsible for tracing and identifying superior breeding stock in sheep & to participate in the implementation of breeding programs enhancing the utilization of such selected animals, to assist the Chief of section.
2. i) Assistant Research Officer Goat of LPRI, Bahadurnagar. ii) Supervise feeding, breeding, management of Goats of LPRI, Bahadurnagar. iii) Perform duties as Analysis and reporting of LPRI, Data on computer.
3. He is responsible for tracing and identifying superior bulls and to participate in the implementation of breeding programme enhancing the utilization of such selected animals, to assist the Chief of the section.
4. He is responsible for collecting and appraising data on the suitabilities of crossbred oxen for draught purposes; to participate in the implementation of crossbreeding programmes cattle improved breeding programme.
5. To assist the Assistant Research Officer of the section; responsible for training and identifying the superior breeding stock; to participate in implementation of indigenous cattle improved breeding programme.
6. To assist the Assistant Research Officer of the Section in the training programs and actual data collection on livestock Management; responsible for research experiments.
7. He is responsible for applied research on feeding for meat production in ruminants, in particular feed lot-fattening of discarded elder stock and full utilization of young stock of inferior productive potential & to assist the Chief of Section.
8. He is responsible for milk analysis including regular fat testing Research & preservation of milk and milk products and to assist the Chief of the Laboratories.
9. Responsible for the introduction of programeters of meat quality and testing of carcasses from experimental animals; also to assist the Chief of the Laboratories.
10. Responsible for chemical analysis of feeds and other laboratories tests required in connection with the activities of Livestock Production Research Institute; also to assist the Chief of Laboratories.
11. Assists the Chief of the section in collection of material and laboratory analysis, investigation in to causes of infertility in cattle and buffalo due to contagious reproductive diseases.
12. Assists the Chief of the section in the investigation of non-contagious disease in livestock; also responsible for the investigation into the causes of infertility due to non-contagious diseases in cattle and buffaloes.
13. To assist the Chief of Extension training section, in particular as liaison officer with the Directorate of Livestock Production Extension and Artificial Insemination.
14. i) To carry out feeding, breeding and management of Dairy Cattle and sheep flock. ii) Supervision of artificial insemination work including collection, evaluation, storage of semen and examination. iii) Responsible for pregnancy tests and fertility of livestock, sheep flock and tenant herd. iv) Maintenance of whole record of Dairy Section/sheep section, distribution of work amongst the labourers. v) To carry out disease control and vaccination.
15. i) To carry out feeding, breeding and management of Dairy Cattle and sheep flock. ii) Supervision of artificial insemination work including collection, evaluation, storage of semen and examination. iii) Responsible for pregnancy tests and fertility of livestock, sheep flock and tenant herd. iv) Maintenance of whole record of Dairy Section/sheep section, distribution of work amongst the labourers. v) To carry out disease control and vaccination.
