MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES AND TASKS

- Ensures availability and full support for manager, Quality Assurance Supervisor (QAS)
 & Section Supervisor (SS).
- 2. Complete required training within specified timeframe. Stays abreast with latest developments in the field. Participates in maintaining hygienic laboratory environment as assigned by manager or SS.
- 3. Receives evidence from Evidence Receiving Unit.
- 4. Conducts case work as per scope of the trace chemistry section.
- 5. Conducts technical and administrative review of co-workers case work.
- 6. Operates, maintains and conducts basic trouble shooting of laboratory instrumentation.
- 7. Evaluates data and issues report to the submitting agency.
- 8. Testifies as an expert witness (Court testimony) as and when directed by manager, SS or QAS (in the absence of manager).
- 9. Participates in research projects under the direction of SS and Trace Lab. Manager.
- 10. Reports to the manager, SS or QAS, if any non-professional practice is being carried out in the laboratory.
- 11. Cleaning of work area sinks and hoods as assigned by manager or SS.
- 12. Ensures the use of appropriate PPE while working in the lab.
