

INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE ANSWER SHEET

- 1) Use a black marker preferably or a blue marker if black is not available.
- 2) Write paper code and fill paper code bubble as printed on the question paper.
- 3) Fill the answer circles (Bubbles) completely and avoid multiple responses.
- 4) Cutting, Erasing and use of any Correction Pen is not allowed.
- 5) Do not fold or damage the answer sheet.
- 6) Machine scoring would be considered final so avoid any stray mark, rough work, additional or improper filling as that may be considered a wrong answer.
- 7) Candidate would be responsible for any incomplete or wrongly filled information and PPSC shall not take any responsibility to rectify the same.
